The chart below features a list of Formulary Select Drugs for select therapeutic classes, as well as a list of suggested, lower-cost alternatives. The use of these alternatives is encouraged through a higher reimbursable rate, which enables you to save money on lower drug costs.

Before obtaining one of the Formulary Select Drugs on this list, ask your doctor to review the suggested alternatives to determine if one is appropriate for you. Please keep in mind that this is not an exhaustive list. It includes some, but not all, of the therapeutically comparable drugs that may be considered alternatives to the Formulary Select drugs in the same therapeutic category or drug class.
